January 10, 2017**

Judge Bishop called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Burdette, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire McKinney. Also present: William Leger, Assistant County Attorney, Joseph Clontz, County Treasurer and Patricia Martin, Fiscal Court Clerk.

MINUTES OF OCTOBER 26, 2016 Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

MINUTES OF DECEMBER 2, 2016 Motion was made by Squire Burdette, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

MINUTES OF DECEMBER 13, 2016 Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

QUAIL PARK REPORT Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to approve the report as presented.

SOLID WASTE REPORTS Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to approve the reports as presented.

CLIMAX VFD 2016 – JULY – DECEMBER UTILITIES Motion was made by Squire Burdette, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to pay \$1,359.66 to Climax VFD for 90% of July – December utilities.

ELECTION PRECINCT OFFICERS PAYMENT Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to raise the pay for election officers from \$100.00 to \$150.00 per day and raise training from \$20.00 to \$30.00 per day.

LIVINGSTON SCHOOL GYM FLOORING Squire Bishop told the fiscal court he was in process getting a bid for rubber flooring for the Livingston Gym. Information Only. No Action.

MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to approve the monthly financial report as presented.

CLAIMS All claims were submitted for payment none was excluded.

TRANSFERS Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to transfer \$150,000 from Occupational to General Fund, Transfer \$20,000 from General Fund to Fairgrounds Fund, transfer \$10,000.00 from General Fund to 911 fund and \$25,000.00 from General Fund to Jail Fund.

CLOSE SESSION

Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to enter into close session.


OPEN SESSION

PERSONNEL Coy Cromer was hired as Road Supervisor for only two years and his two years are up. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to hire Mark Blanton as Road Supervisor for the next two years and to make Coy Cromer and Gilbert Chesnut as Assistant Supervisors. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with Squire Burdette, voting nay and Squire Bishop, Squire McKinney, Squire McGuire and Squire Denny voting aye to pay Mark Blanton \$15.55 for the first 6 months and then increase \$1.00 after 6 months' probation. Motion carried. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to pay Gilbert Chesnut \$15.55 per hour. Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to pay Coy Cromer his current pay of \$16.55 for six months then lower to \$15.55.

Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Burdette, with all voting aye to get two more cell phones and to give Mark Blanton Coy's truck.

Motion was made by Squire Burdette to adjourn.
