CBDG RESOLUTION – Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye for Rockcastle County Fiscal Court to apply for Community Development Block Grant Funds from the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Department for Local Government.

RCIDA Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Judge Bishop, with all voting aye for RCIDA to operate by their By-Laws and the Kentucky Revised Statues 154.501-301 – 155.5-346.
