Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Denny, Squire Prewitt, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire and Squire Thacker. Also present: Jeremy Rowe, County Attorney, and Patricia Martin, Fiscal Court Clerk. Absent Joseph Clontz, County Treasurer.

CITIZENS BANK LOAN EXTENSION Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to extend the Citizens Bank maturity date by 2 months from 2/27/19 to 4/27/19 and authorize County Judge Executive Howell Holbrook Jr. to sign all necessary documents. (See Attached)
