ROCKCASTLE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye for RCIDA to enter into a non-exclusive consulting agreement with Five Talents Financial Group to either sale or lease the Plastics Building.

KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET RESOLUTION Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to sign the Resolution adopting and approving the execution of a Rural Secondary Program Agreement between the Fiscal Court and the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Rural and Municipal Aid and accepting all roads and streets referred to therein as being a part of the County Road System.

KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET AGREEMENT Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to enter into an agreement by and between the Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Rural and Municipal Aid and Rockcastle County Fiscal Court. The Department shall be responsible for providing Rural Secondary funding in an amount not to exceed \$243,714.0 and the Fiscal Court will be responsible for the remaining amount due. 
