

**Rockcastle County Fiscal Court  
Regular Called Meeting  
October 9, 2018**

Judge Bishop called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire McKinney. Also present: Jeremy Rowe, County Attorney, Joseph Clontz, County Treasurer and Patricia Martin, Fiscal Court Clerk. Absent Squire Burdette.

**VISITOR**

**Melinda Gillum Dalton** was at the fiscal court meeting to ask for support in her running for Family Court Judge.

**MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 11, 2019** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

**MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 24, 2018** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

**ROCKCASTLE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to give \$5,128.16 to Rockcastle County Industrial Authority for program support.

**SENIOR CITIZENS BUILDING** Jason Martin with Division of Real Property with the State asked the Judge if the county would consider taking over the Senior Citizens Building. They would give it to the County. No Action.

**DAR – TONYA COOK** Tonya Cook with DAR was at the Fiscal Court meeting to ask for help in purchasing food and clean up for the Veteran's Day event this year. She told the court they were celebrating 100<sup>th</sup> year with 516 veterans. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to donate \$575.00 to DAR for the event.

**CEMETERY BOARD** The cemetery board is working to publishing a new cemetery book for the county. They were asking for use of the office copier and paper to work on the book. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to allow the cemetery board to use the copier after closing to work on the book.

**RCHS SWIM TEAM** The Fiscal Court is not allowed to provide for School related programs.

**CSEPP – AMBULANCE COTS** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to sign a letter for CSEPP, stating that Rockcastle County Ambulances require Stryker Power-Pro cots.

**SOLID WASTE REPORTS** Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to approve the reports as presented.

**RECYCLING CENTER – HIRE 2 PART TIME** James Renner, Solid Waste Coordinator was at the Fiscal Court Meeting to ask the court to hire 2 part time employees at the rate of \$10.00 per hour to pick up litter. He told the court that he had not had inmate labor for some time now and is behind on roadside litter pick up and he needed about 350 miles of roadside picked up between now and December 31, 2018 in order to be in compliance with the Litter Abatement Grant Agreement with the state. If we do not meet the state requirements by the end of the year, the state can hold Rockcastle County out of compliance and could potentially withhold all state funding coming into Rockcastle County for 2019. He told the court he would be allowed to charge off employee labor of the Litter Abatement Grant for roadside trash pick-up only. He received \$33,510.72 in Litter Abatement funding for calendar year 2018. As of August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 he has \$8,310.68 remaining. Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to hire 2 part time employees at a rate of \$10.00 per hour to pick up litter.

**QUAIL PARK REPORT** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the reports as presented.

**WINDSTREAM MAINTENANCE CONTRACT** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to sign a one year maintenance agreement with Windstream in the amount of \$1,315.17.

**SHERIFF'S QUIETUS** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to accept the Sheriff's 2017 Quietus as presented.

**JUVENILE TRANSPORTS** Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to pay the Sheriff's office for mileage for juvenile transports in the amount of \$779.94.

**CLAYTON SINGLETON ROAD – SQUIRE LN** Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to change Clayton Singleton Road name back to Squire Ln.

**MCCALL KNOB ROAD** Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to take McCall Knob Road into the county maintained road system.

**ADMINISTRATIVE CODE** The Judge told the Fiscal court that the Administrative Code needed to be work on and some changes made. No Action.

**STEVE MINK – PERSONAL TIME** Motion was made by Judge Bishop, seconded by Squire Bishop with all voting aye to pay Steve Mink his remaining 4.75 hours of personal time.

**RESOLUTION – FIRE TRUCK LOAN** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to sign the resolution approving a lease for the financing of the Mt. Vernon Fire Truck in the amount of \$75,000.00.

**WYNN FIRE EQUIPMENT - \$75,000.00** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to pay Wynn Fire Equipment in the amount of \$75,000.00 when funding is received from KACo.

**MONTHLY FINANCIAL REPORT** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to approve the monthly financial report as presented.

**CLAIMS** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve all claims as submitted.

**TRANSFERS** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to transfer \$100,000.00 from Occupational Fund to General Fund, transfer \$15,000.00 from General Fund to LGEA fund, and transfer \$1,000.00 from General Fund to Fairground fund.

**FLEX FUNDS** Motion was made by Squire McKinney, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to remove Cedar Thicket Ln, Mullins Station Rd & Clayton Singleton Rd from the list for FLEX funding and process the request with the rest of roads remaining.
