Regular Called Meeting  
September 11, 2018**

Judge Bishop called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Burdette, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire McKinney. Also present: Jeremy Rowe, County Attorney, Joseph Clontz, County Treasurer and Patricia Martin, Fiscal Court Clerk.

**MINUTES OF AUGUST 14, 2018** Motion was made by Squire Burdette, seconded by Squire McKinney, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

**MINUTES OF AUGUST 21, 2018** Motion was made by Squire Burdette, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

**MINUTES OF AUGUST 31, 2018** Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the minutes as read.

**TONY ARVIN, HEALTH & WELLNESS** Tony Arvin was at the fiscal court to voice concerns over the loaded trucks coming through town due to widening of the interstate and work at Microfoodery. Judge Bishop told him we as a fiscal court we couldn't do anything about the trucks due to it being a U.S. Highway.

**MELANIE ABBOTT – RESIDENTS ON WILDE RD** Melanie Abbott was at the fiscal court to discuss about her neighbor. The fiscal court told her she would have to discuss this with the sheriff or an Attorney because the Fiscal Court couldn't legally do anything about the problem.

Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to sign a letter of support to the Rockcastle Chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution in their endeavor to place a Patriot monument for the first veterans of this country on our courthouse lawn.

**RESCIND BLACKTOP BID** Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to rescind Lipps Blacktop Bid due to not be able to perform the county’s work.

**MT. VERNON VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Judge Bishop, to purchase a 2004 International truck for Mt. Vernon Fire Department in the amount of \$75,000.00 from Wynn Fire Equipment with Squire Denny and Squire McKinney voting nay and Squire Burdette, Squire Bishop and Squire McGuire voting aye. Motion carried.
