March 10, 2020**

Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire Prewitt. Also present: County Attorney, Jeremy Rowe, County Treasurer, Joseph Clontz, and Fiscal Court Clerk, Patricia Martin.

**MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 11, 2020** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Denny with all voting aye to approve the minutes as presented.

**MINUTES OF FEBRUARY 26, 2020** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Thacker with all voting aye to approve the minutes as presented.

**ROCKCASTLE COUNTY STUDENT COUNCIL** Rockcastle County Student Council gave a presentation to the court about the importance of the county residents to participate in the 2020 Census Count.

**SHERIFF’S OFFICE** Motion by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve Sheriff’s January – April 2018 Settlement Tax Audit Invoice for \$9,430.66. Motion by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to approve Sheriff’s April – December 2018 Settlement Tax audit for \$7,980.70. Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve paying \$16,556.00 to L&W Emergency Equipment for the sheriff’s new vehicles equipment.

**LEASE AGREEMENT OF THE SENIOR CITIZENS BUILDING** – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the lease of the Senior Citizens Center to Rockcastle County Senior Citizens, Inc. for \$1 per year for 10 years, March 2030.

**JOHNSON CONTROLS – Five Year Pipe Inspection** – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve the proposal and agreement from Johnson Controls for the Annex’s 5 year pipe inspection in the amount of \$850.00.

Motion by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Prewitt, with all voting aye to approve the Intra-Fund transfers as presented.
