KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET RESOLUTION Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve resolution adopting and approving the execution of a Memorandum of Agreement between the Rockcastle County Fiscal Court and Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways for in the amount of \$683,644 for the project of resurfacing of various county roads.

KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET AGREEMENT Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to sign an agreement between Commonwealth of Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, Department of Highways and Rockcastle County Fiscal Court for in the amount of \$683,644 for the project of resurfacing of various county roads.


1. Chestnut Grove Road (CR 1365) from KY 2250 extending northerly to KY 1505 for approximately 43698 miles.
2. Purrgsby Road (CR 1405) from Mile point 0.468 extending southerly to KY 1326 for approximately 1.206 miles.
3. Stephens Road (CR 1058) from Mile point 0.170 extending westerly to Little Clear Creek Road for approximately 1.678 miles.
4. Sinking Valley Springs Road (CR 1065) from KY 1617 extending westerly to Old State Road for approximately 1.511 miles.
5. Old State Road (CR 1056) from KY 1617 extending northerly to Fairview Loop Road for approximately 4.571 miles.
