SNOW FLAKE SPEED LIMIT Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to set a 30 mph speed limit on Snow Flake Rd.

SECLUDED RIDGE Residents from Secluded Ridge were at the Fiscal Court meeting to discuss it being taken into the County Road Maintenance System. The Judge told the Fiscal Court that Secluded Ridge had been platted as a subdivision. Judge Holbrook told the Fiscal Court he had the Attorney General Opinion which prohibited the county accepted the county road in its current condition. Squire McGuire stated that the county had previously taken over roads in subdivisions, and he made a motion to take it in, seconded by Squire Bishop, with Squire McGuire, Squire Bishop, voting aye and Squire Thacker, Squire Denny and Squire Prewitt voting nay. Motion failed.
