**ROCKCASTLE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY**—RCIDA’s monthly budget was reviewed, showing a surplus of \$5,401.58. Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to accept the RCIDA budget as presented.


