January 11, 2022**

Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Prewitt, and Squire Denny. Also present: Jailer Nathan Carter, County Attorney Jeremy Rowe, Deputy Sam Brock, County Treasurer Joe Clontz and Fiscal Court Clerk Vickie Miller.

**MINUTES OF DECEMBER 14, 2021** - Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve the minute as presented.
