

**Rockcastle County Fiscal Court
Special Called Meeting
March 29, 2022**

Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire Prewitt. Also present: Jailer Nathan Carter, County Attorney Jeremy Rowe, County Treasurer Joseph Clontz and Fiscal Court Clerk Vickie Miller.

CLOSE SESSION – Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to go into close session.

OPEN SESSION - Motion was made by Squire Thacker , seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to return to open session.

CHAPIN CONTRACT – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Bishop with all voting aye to the extension of Chapin’s payoff agreement from March 31, 2022 to April 30, 2022.

FY 2022-2023 JAIL BUDGET- Nathan Carter, Jailer, submitted his proposed Jail budget for Fiscal Year 2022-2023. Information only.

BANK ACCOUNT FOR FARMERS MKT – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Prewitt with all voting aye to approve a Farmer’s Market bank account and the transferring of the minimum amount for the account. The rental of the building will fund the account and be used to pay for all expenditures for the building.

BRODHEAD FIRE DEPARTMENT – Brodhead Volunteer Fire Department Fire Chief John Dyehouse asked for help in purchasing a 25 hp motor for a boat they will be purchasing for water rescues. The cost of the motor will be approximately \$4,300. Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Bishop with all voting aye to approve the amount of \$4,300.

ELECTRICAL INSPECTORS – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to remove Garfield (Todd) Cobb from the County’s approved electrical inspectors list. Mr. Cobb requested the removal due to him not wanting to work in Rockcastle County.


