

**Rockcastle County Fiscal Court  
Regular Called Meeting  
April 12, 2022**

Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Prewitt, and Squire Denny. Also present: Sheriff Shannon Franklin, Jailer Nathan Carter, County Attorney Jeremy Rowe, Treasurer Joseph Clontz and Fiscal Court Clerk Vickie Miller.

**MINUTES OF MARCH 8, 2022-** Motion was made by Squire Bishop, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve the minute as presented.

**MINUTES OF MARCH 29, 2022 -** Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the minute as presented.

**ROCKCASTLE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY REPORT -** RCIDA's monthly budget was reviewed, showing a surplus of \$6,131.78. Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Prewitt, with all voting aye to accept the RCIDA budget as presented.

**ROCKCASTLE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT BOARD PROGRAM SUPPORT \$1,284.64 -** Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Prewitt, with all voting aye to approve Rockcastle County Development Board's program support for \$1,284.64.

**BLAST IN THE VALLEY-** Tourism Commission requested at donation of \$20,000 for this year's Blast in the Valley. Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire Bishop with all voting aye to table the vote till next meeting.

**SECOND AND FINAL READING OF COUNTY ROAD NETWORK ORDINANCE –** Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the Second and Final Reading of the County Road Network System Ordinance.

**DANETTA ALLEN, ROCKCASTLE COUNTY CLERK –** Clerk informed the Fiscal Court on the reasons why the County Board of Elections made the decision to reduce the voting locations down to four, Rockcastle County Courthouse, Roundstone Elementary School, Brodhead Elementary School, and Livingston Volunteer Fire Department. The cost of supplying machines to multiple locations and the difficulty of finding precinct workers were the major reasons for the reduction of voting locations.

This is reimbursement funding from FEMA for Disaster 4595 \$8,620.45 and Disaster 4592 \$17,834.99.

**INTER-TRANSFERS** – Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve the transfer of \$182,500 from Occupational Fund to General Fund, \$60,000 from General Fund to Jail Fund, \$30,000 from General Fund to 911 Fund and \$7,500 from General Fund to the Fairgrounds Fund.
