

Rockcastle County Fiscal Court
Regular Called Meeting
May 10, 2022

Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Bishop, Squire McGuire, Squire Prewitt, and Squire Denny. Also present: Sheriff Shannon Franklin, Jailer Nathan Carter, County Attorney Jeremy Rowe, Treasurer Joseph Clontz and Fiscal Court Clerk Vickie Miller.

MINUTES OF APRIL 12, 2022- Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire Bishop, with all voting aye to approve the minute as presented.

MINUTES OF APRIL 29, 2022 - Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to approve the minute as presented.

ROCKCASTLE COUNTY INDUSTRIAL AUTHORITY REPORT - RCIDA's monthly budget was reviewed, showing a surplus of \$6,699.54. Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Denny, with all voting aye to accept the RCIDA budget as presented. RCIDA Director Jeff VanHook informed the court the Delta Gas Line's ARC Grant of \$450,000 has been deposited into the Fiscal Court's Federal Funds account. He was in the process of getting a new ARC Grant Fund account at Citizens Bank to transfer the funds into.

ROCKCASTLE COUNTY DEVELOPMENT BOARD PROGRAM SUPPORT \$1,255. - Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve Rockcastle County Development Board's program support for \$1,255.

ROCKCASTLE COUNTY EXTENSION DISTRICT BOARD 2022-2023 BUDGET - Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire McGuire, with all voting aye to accept the Rockcastle County Extension District Board 2022– 2023 budget as presented.

AMERICAN RED CROSS DONATION \$2,500 –Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Thacker with all voting aye to approve \$2,500 in support of the American Red Cross.

ROCKCASTLE HISTORICAL SOCIETY OFFICE SPACE – Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to allow the Rockcastle Historical Society to use the 2nd glassed in office currently used by Lynn Tatum. Lynn Tatum will be moving out in the near future to her new office in the Chamber of Commerce building.

ROCKCASTLE COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD MEMBERS - Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire Prewitt, with all voting aye to appoint Brenda Saylor to Rockcastle County Library Board. Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Denny with all voting aye to appoint Barbara Congleton to the Rockcastle County Library Board.

COURTHOUSE BRICK REPAIRS – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to approve the advertising for bids for the repair of the brick on the courthouse.

AOC REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT – Motion was made by Squire Thacker, seconded by Squire Prewitt with all voting aye to accept the AOC Reimbursement agreement with an estimated reimbursement of \$167,328.00.

KENTUCKY TRANSPORTATION CABINET RECOMMENDATIONS 2022-2023 - Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Thacker with all voting aye to accept the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet's recommendations for resurfacing KY 618 from milepost 6.3 and extend 0.858 miles to KY 1250 and KY 2614 from milepost 5.15 and extend 1.061 miles to KY 1912 and the allocation of \$236,535 for Flex funding.

BEE GARBAGE INVOICE FOR TRASH DROP-OFF DAY \$16,350.00 - Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire McGuire with all voting aye to approve payment of \$16,350.

KACO UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE – Motion was made by Squire McGuire, seconded by Squire Denny with all voting aye to approve the Fiscal Court Unemployment Insurance \$1,366.05. Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Denny with all voting aye to approve the Sheriff's Unemployment Insurance \$1,078.69. Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Prewitt with all voting aye to approve the Jail's Unemployment Insurance \$1,778.55.

ROCKCASTLE SHERIFF COURT SECURITY UPDATE – Sherriff Franklin informed the court starting July 1, 2022 the Legislature passed and the Governor signed the bill increasing the pay of court security bailiffs to \$15 per hour. Sheriff Franklin stated this increase will impact his budget at \$8,500 for this year.

TRANSFER FEMA \$450,000 FROM FEDERAL FUNDS TO RCIDA – Motion was made by Squire Denny, seconded by Squire Prewitt, with all voting aye to approve the transfer of \$450,000 from the Federal Funds account to the RCIDA's new ARC Grant Fund. The RCIDA ARC Grant for the Delta Gas Line Project was deposited into the Fiscal Court's Federal Fund account.

INTER-TRANSFERS – Motion was made by Squire Prewitt, seconded by Squire Thacker, with all voting aye to approve the transfer of \$356,500 from Occupational Fund to General Fund, \$105,000 from General Fund to Jail Fund, \$50,000 from General Fund to 911 Fund and \$1,500 from General Fund to the Forestry Fund.
