Judge Holbrook called the meeting to order with the following present: Squire Thacker, Squire Adams, Squire McGuire, Squire Denny and Squire Prewitt. Also present: Deputy Sheriff Ronnie Bradley, County Attorney Jeremy Rowe, Jailer Nathan Carter, and Fiscal Court Clerk/Treasurer Vickie Miller.

**LIVINGSTON MAYOR LARRY DAVIDSON** — Mayor Davidson asked the Court to consider signing an Memorandum of Understanding (MOA) with the city of Livingston for the leasing of the 40 acres the county owns in Livingston. He stated Livingston would like to apply for grants and to invest in the property for tourism if the city had control of the property. The Fiscal Court asked County Attorney Jeremy Rowe to look into the insurance liability for the county and to start the process of creating the MOA for the county.
