Items that will be accepted

Televisions and monitors: flat screen or old-fashioned tube

Computers: desktop, laptop, tablet (for example, iPad)

Computer hardware: scanner, printer, keyboard, mouse, router, modem

Office equipment: copiers, fax machines, electric typewriters

Telephones: cell phone and landline, answering machines

Small appliances, including microwaves ovens

Other electronic devices:

iPods, MP3 players

Stereos, speakers

CD, VCR, DVD players

Headphones

Radios

Digital cameras

Pagers

Calculators

Wire

GPS devices

Lithium batteries

Motors

Items NOT accepted

Smoke detectors

Large appliances (refrigerators, etc.)

Lead-acid batteries, alkaline batteries

Light bulbs: incandescent, fluorescent, LED
